Cumbria NPNP- a broad overview

Here in Cumbria we are really lucky to have a National Methodist strategy-NPNP that fits so naturally into our local Ecumenical God For All strategy.

We want to see God's Kingdom grow and to see a flourishing church in Cumbria. A parable of a garden helps us visualise this-A Mixed Ecology of Church- a mix of time honoured and fresh expressions and pioneering forms of church.

In Cumbria our NPNP project has 3 strands-

1-Across the Top- A district wide online church, Offering a broad spiritual space to attract those seeking but who may never look within our existing church walls.

2-Church at the Margins (CaM)- Exploring what it means to nurture and build communities amongst economically marginalised people.

3-Culture Change- Making the MIssional Shift- facilitating a change towards FX & Pioneering orientation within our circuits.




Cumbria NPNP- an update

Our application was made to connexion in Jan 2024 and the officers recommended our proposals to the Connexional Mission Committee, who agreed them and to make funds available for us to continue with our proposed 3 strand project approach.

- Rev Phil Jackson will lead on the Across the Top project which will begin 'properly' with Phil in post from Sept 24, with the online platform due to launch in Jan 25.
- Work continues in Barrow, exploring the Church at the Margins project there as well as looking to 'Lets End Poverty' for their learning and experience in running Food Pantry's instead of Food Banks and seeing what we can adopt here in Cumbria.
- I will remain in post leading on the 3rd strand of the overall project, working with churches and circuits to help them navigate this new time and work out what their pioneering response will be. Many circuits are already engaged, and people are stepping into unknown territory with the commitment to connect wider and deeper into their communities so that God may be known and the church may flourish here. It is exciting to be part of this work- and I look forward to journeying with more of you as you begin to join in.
